We were doing the construction, so there were a lot of tools involved. On my first day I wasn't aware of the names of most tools. Learning the names and functions of each tool was exciting. Being a man, I felt safer knowing these things. Construction also involves math and intelligent thinking. On my first day I only watched the processes take place. Eventually, I was helping to make the decisions. I even helped a volunteer build a fence and make accurate measurements. Building education will benefit me for the rest of my life. The amount of respect I earned was an unparalleled benefit I received from community service. Oil companies volunteered their employees on Saturdays and I talked to all of them. They recognized my enrollment and scholarship achievements. Some of them see me and recognize me around town and ask me about how my goals are going. During the project, I learned from the challenges I encountered. I participated in the recruitment of volunteers at the Volunteer Fair and cube collection on Lollipop Day. During the Service Learning experience I realized that the culture of volunteers in Ireland is very different than in the United States. I'm studying at University College Dublin for a semester in an overseas curriculum. Student organizations at U.S. universities encourage and facilitate opportunities for their members to volunteer. One of the student organizations I was involved in at my home university requires ten hours of volunteering per semester, forcing me to complete community service hours. My home university, Virginia Commonwealth University, has services that organize and connect students with volunteer opportunities. Volunteering is fairly common in the United States. On the other hand, in Ireland, volunteering does not seem so common or popular. Charities in Ireland generally have a bad reputation because former CEOs pocket money from donation. Local students in my group informed me that they have only volunteered with the school when they were younger, confirming that volunteering is not common among university students in Ireland. This was my first time volunteering with this organization, and a large crowd showed up that day. There were three large prefabricated main course trays, and they sold out completely in the first hour. Another volunteer had to microwave a lot of canned ravioli. Those who visit this soup eat know exactly what and how much they could eat and will ask for the exact amount so that nothing is wasted. Other observations confirm what we learned in class, because at least half of the privileged people who visit this dining room are overweight. It is safe to assume that they have an unbalanced diet, and do not have enough nutrient intake on a daily basis. There were a lot of expired bread products that will be donated by Safeway for free to anyone. However, due to the bad rainy weather, there was clearly a decrease in the number of people visiting the dining room early in the shift. Almost no family group visiting together, on the other hand, a person would come to pick up food for the family. Because of the rain, those who choose to eat in the dining room ate inside. Coincidentally, most of today's visitors came as a group, then sat down and enjoyed the food together. The supervisor wanted to treat them today, for dessert; We gave them very delicious-looking cakes. At the end of the day, they ate four large cakes and two cakes. While working, I learned that this organization manages the dining room from different places every day for at least two meals a day in Livermore and Pleasanton. They also provide prepared lunches to disadvantaged schools. It's surprising how much the people of this city care about the underprivileged, a little more than other cities around America and the rest of the world. The location of the Friday shift is in a church, and this church offers the homeless a place to sleep during the climates to some degree. A warm room to sleep in; ceiling and walls to protect them from the cold at night, this church rotates with others throughout the week in order to prevent neighbors from complaining about homeless community service is something I have grown up doing. Throughout my life I have offered much of my time to organizations within my community. I have served in the community dining room, helped the young members of the Monett Water Thrasher Swim Team improve their punches, and offered as a table worker at the Monett High School and Monett Youth Club wrestling tournaments.
